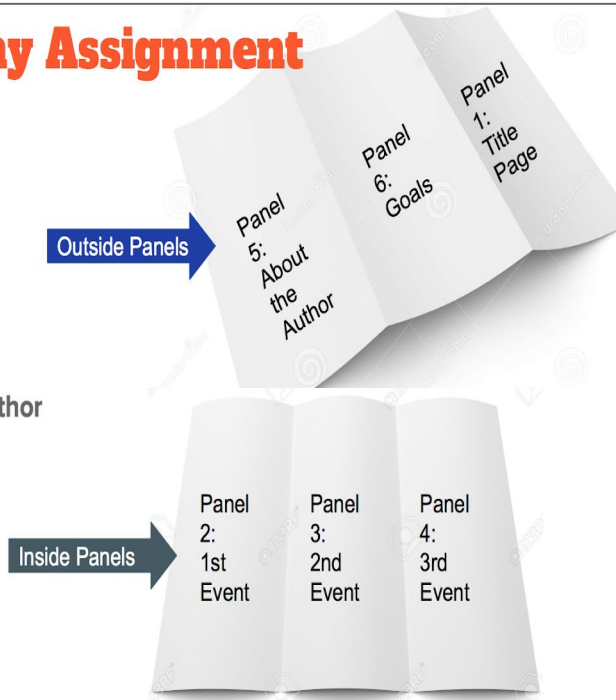


Autobiography Assignment

Panels:

- Panel 1: Front Cover
- Panel 2: 1st Event
- Panel 3: 2nd Event
- Panel 4: 3rd Event
- Panel 5: About the Author
- Panel 6: Goals



Panel 1:

- Make a title page for your autobiography. Include a title and an illustration.

Panels 2-4

- You are going to write about important events that have shaped you as a person. This means that you are selecting a total of three important events in your life. For each of the three events, write a narrative (story) describing what happened. Make sure you describe it from start to finish. Pretend that someone who doesn't know you will be reading the story and trying to understand it. Be sure to include details! Illustrate each event with a small, hand-illustrated picture.

Panel 5:

- Write a brief "About the Author" section. Include your name, place and date of birth, interests and hobbies, and anything else you want people to know about you. Include a self-portrait.

Panel 6:

- Write about your goals. Include what you want to do after high school, what career and/or family goals you may have, what you hope to learn in my class this year, what goals you have for yourself this year, obstacles you might be facing that could prevent you from achieving your goals, and who is rooting for you to succeed both at school and/or outside of school.
